- Nebraska City Unit 1 – Capacity Factor: 79.8%
- Nebraska City Unit 2 – Capacity Factor: 88.6%
- North Omaha Unit 4 – Capacity Factor: 63%
- North Omaha Unit 5 – Capacity Factor: 72.1%

August Balancing Generation

- Cass County – Capacity Factor 19.5%
- Jones Street – Capacity Factor 0%
- North Omaha Unit 1 – Capacity Factor 2%
- North Omaha Unit 2 – Capacity Factor .8%
- North Omaha Unit 3 – Capacity Factor 9%
- Sarpy County – Capacity Factor 12.6%

August Renewables

- Renewable energy contributed 25.2% of OPPD's retail energy sales.
- Wind capacity factor of 36.5%
- Capacity Factor for Community Solar 29.9%.
