Builder Installed Service Duct

It is the policy of the Omaha Public Power District that the lot owner or builder must install a service conduit for each lot, as provided in section 1.2 of the OPPD Underground Service Agreement:

1.2 Underground service lines from underground distribution lines to individual lots or dwelling units will be provided by OPPD from a point of connection on the dwelling unit to OPPD's nearest point of power supply. The lot owner or builder will be responsible for providing and installing a service conduit from OPPD transformer/pedestal to the meter socket for every individual lot in the subdivision per OPPD Meter Manual specifications.

The issue on whether or not to require installation of a service conduit for lots in SIDs covered by other Underground Service Agreements will be readdressed in 2014.
