# September Baseload Generation

- Nebraska City Unit 1 – Capacity Factor: 41.8%
- Nebraska City Unit 2 – Capacity Factor: 12.9%
- North Omaha Unit 4 – Capacity Factor: 51.3%
- North Omaha Unit 5 – Capacity Factor: 61.3%

# September Balancing Generation

- Cass County – Capacity Factor 8.4%
- Jones Street – Capacity Factor 0.2%
- North Omaha Unit 1 – Capacity Factor 0%
- North Omaha Unit 2 – Capacity Factor 0.7%
- North Omaha Unit 3 – Capacity Factor 24%
- Sarpy County – Capacity Factor 6.5%

# September Renewables

- Renewable energy contributed 31.6% of OPPD's retail energy sales
- Wind capacity factor of 40.3%
- Capacity Factor for Community Solar 26.5%

## Behind the Meter Solar Workshops

- Hosted two interactive workshops – one residential and one commercial
- Goal was to learn customer preferences of rooftop solar and what key program attributes would increase rooftop solar system adoption across the district
