October Baseload Generation

- Nebraska City Unit 1 – Capacity Factor: 62.3%
- Nebraska City Unit 2 – Capacity Factor: 60.4%
- North Omaha Unit 4 – Capacity Factor: 63.7%
- North Omaha Unit 5 – Capacity Factor: 58.3%

October Balancing Generation

- Cass County – Capacity Factor 1.4%
- Jones Street – Capacity Factor 0.4%
- North Omaha Unit 1 – Capacity Factor 0%
- North Omaha Unit 2 – Capacity Factor 0%
- North Omaha Unit 3 – Capacity Factor 8.4%
- Sarpy County – Capacity Factor 5.7%

October Renewables

- Renewable energy contributed 39.9% of OPPD's retail energy sales
- Wind capacity factor of 45%
- Capacity Factor for Community Solar 22.4%

OPPD's first battery storage project hit a major milestone on October 25th



The battery was delivered to an OPPD substation in Cass County. The project team will work to finish installation and commission the asset, with anticipated operation planned for early 2023.
