

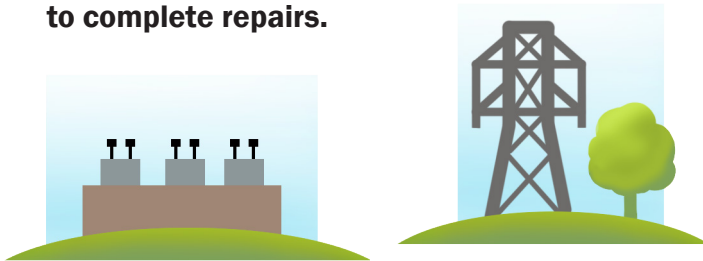
Reconnect power safely after a flood



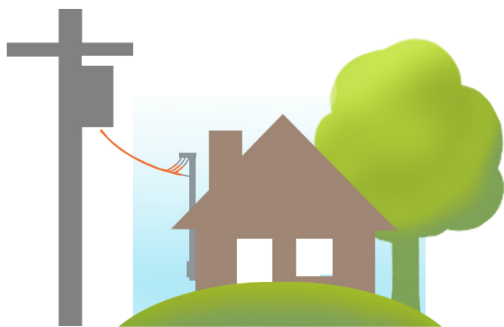
When an area is flooded, your power may be disrupted or disconnected.



Prior to reconnecting, you must contact your local inspection and permitting agency. In some cases, you may need an electrician to complete repairs.



Once OPPD is allowed access to the flooded area, we will repair damage to our electrical system.



Once OPPD has received an approved permit from your permitting agency and repaired our system, power will be restored.
