# February Baseload Generation

- Nebraska City Unit 1 – Capacity Factor: 71.4%
- Nebraska City Unit 2 – Capacity Factor: 54.5%
- North Omaha Unit 4 – Capacity Factor: 63.3%
- North Omaha Unit 5 – Capacity Factor: 27.3%

# February Peaking Generation

- Cass County – Capacity Factor 18.9%
- Jones Street – Capacity Factor 10.4%
- North Omaha Unit 1 – Capacity Factor 0%
- North Omaha Unit 2 – Capacity Factor 0%
- North Omaha Unit 3 – Capacity Factor 0%
- Sarpy County – Capacity Factor 5.3%

# February Renewables

- Renewable energy contributed 24% of OPPD's retail energy sales.
- Wind capacity factor of 30.9%.
- Capacity Factor for Community Solar 11.6%.
- Capacity Factor for Community Solar YTD is 10.3%.
