Terms and Conditions

By agreeing to participate in the Renewable Choice Program, Participants agree to the qualifications, terms, and conditions of the program, as the same may be changed from time to time by OPPD.

Program Details

The Renewable Choice Program allows customers to voluntarily support renewable energy and offset their carbon emissions by purchasing renewable energy Certificates (RECs) supplied by the Omaha Public Power District (OPPD). Program participants have the option to match their energy usage with RECs in increments of 10%, ranging from 10% to 100%.

Program Qualifications

Participant must be an OPPD customer with OPPD account(s) in good standing and be taking service under Rate Schedule Numbers 110, 115, 226, 230, or 230M.

Program Terms and Conditions

1. Participants are billed monthly based on their energy usage, the chosen energy usage match percentage, and the price of the program as determined by OPPD. See www.OPPD.com/RenewableChoice for current pricing.
2. Participants will not receive a physical copy of the RECs from OPPD for RECs purchased under this program. However, RECs purchased by Participants will be retired annually by OPPD on the Participants' behalf. OPPD will provide documentation of retired RECs on its website on an annual basis.
3. Participants cannot transfer the underlying environmental attributes reflected in purchased RECs to any party.
4. OPPD intends to review the price for RECs on an annual basis to determine if the pricing should change. OPPD may be required to alter the price more frequently than



annually to address unanticipated events (e.g. demand for RECs exceeds supply). Participants will be notified in advance of any price changes.

5. RECs are distributed on a first come, first served basis based on the most recent enrollment date.
6. Participation in this program does not constitute or represent ownership of any renewable resources.
7. Participation in this program will continue indefinitely unless terminated in writing either by the Participant or by OPPD. Termination of participation in this Program will be effective on the date of the Participant's next billing period.
