

# Solar Rebate Program Terms and Conditions

March 2026



PROGRAM RULES AND DETAILS ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE WITHOUT NOTICE.

## Qualifications for Program

Rebate recipient must be an OPPD customer with OPPD account(s) in good standing. The person or entity receiving a rebate may not qualify for other related rebates in the same calendar year. Systems must be installed or sold by a current Participant in the OPPD Customer-Owned Generation (COG) Trade Ally Program

## General Terms and Conditions

- 1) This program is subject to change or cancellation by OPPD without notice.
- 2) Each rebate amount is \$2,000.
- 3) A dated, itemized invoice for all equipment must be submitted within 30 days of project completion to receive a rebate. OPPD may verify sales and inspect the project at any time.
- 4) OPPD reserves the right to install a metering device on existing and new equipment to verify energy production.
- 5) Rebates are available on a first-come, first-served basis.
- 6) Submitting incomplete or missing information may delay processing of the rebate.
- 7) The customer/contractor certifies that each solar project complies with all federal, state and local safety, building and environmental codes.
- 8) OPPD is granted the right to publicize a rebate recipient's name as a participant in the Solar Rebate Program, unless such rebate recipient opts-out of such publicity by specifically stating otherwise in writing and forwarding such notice to [ProductsandServices@oppd.com](mailto:ProductsandServices@oppd.com).
- 9) Falsifying any information may lead to cancellation of this and future rebate applications, a claim by OPPD for the return of any rebate payments and/or the exercise by OPPD of available legal remedies.
- 10) Recipient agrees to retain sole ownership of or transfer to OPPD all Renewable Energy Credits and any other environmental benefits associated with recipient's solar photovoltaic system (the "System").
- 11) Recipient agrees that they will not enter into an agreement or arrangement with any third party for the use of the recipient's System for any market services including but not limited to energy, capacity, spinning reserves, supplemental/non-spinning reserves, frequency, voltage or inertial regulation, and other ancillary services.
- 12) Any pre-approved rebate is reserved for 120 days; if the project doesn't reach project completion in that time, funds are released and the project must be resubmitted.

## **Solar Project Requirements**

- 1) Minimum System size is 3 kW. System size is determined as the maximum power export capability (kWAC) of the System.
- 2) Expansions of existing Systems are eligible for a rebate if the aggregate System size exceeds the minimum System size and a rebate was not given for the original System.
- 3) All inverters and photovoltaic panels must be new, not used.
- 4) The System must be approved by OPPD, interconnected to the OPPD grid, and attached to a non-mobile structure on a permanent foundation.
- 5) The System must be approved for construction by OPPD prior to submission of invoice to OPPD.
- 6) Rebate applications must be submitted on behalf of the recipient by a current Participant in the OPPD COG Trade Ally Program.

## **Additional Criteria and Disclaimers**

- 1) If the System is removed from the OPPD service territory or disconnected from the OPPD grid within 10 years of installation, the applicant may be subject to a prorated forfeiture of the rebate received.
- 2) OPPD reserves the right to limit any rebate payment to an amount not to exceed 50% of the total material/equipment cost for the project.
- 3) Rebates are payable to person or entity specified in the rebate application.
- 4) Only one rebate may be paid per calendar year for a given address or OPPD premise.
- 5) A Participant in the OPPD COG Trade Ally Program will not be eligible for and shall not retain any rebate issued by OPPD under the Solar Rebate Program.
- 6) OPPD does not endorse or warranty any contractors, manufacturers, products or system designs by offering or paying a solar rebate payment.
- 7) The number of rebates available for a specific project and/or development from a single applicant or related applicants shall be limited to a single rebate.
